We should have a stick-to-it attitude as an example for others to learn to never give up. *Hebrews 12:1-2*

Those who live in honor will be able to mentor others on how to live in honor. *John 5:23* **Truth** – We should be followers, seekers, and discerners of God's Truth. Bible reading, memorization, and study should be a part of everyone's spiritual walk. We should be able to discern between a secular brand of truth and the truth found in God's Word. Knowing biblical truths will help disciple others in knowing biblical truth and hopefully encourage them to seek and follow biblical truth. *Psalm 25:5* 

**Wisdom** – We should not only know biblical truths, but also apply them to our lives as practical and spiritual wisdom. We should know by experience that God gives His wisdom to those who ask. Spiritual wisdom helps people to grow and develop spiritually. The spiritually wise person will be able to teach this wisdom to others as part of their mentoring process. *James 3:17* 

## Statement Of Faith

HCA is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and fully supports its educational integrity and theological stance. Therefore, HCA has adopted the Statement of Faith as summarized by ACSI, because it represents well the Biblical view of HCA as a conservative, evangelical school.

**We believe** the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:21). **We believe** there is one God, eternally existent in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30).

**We believe** in the deity of Christ (John 10:33), His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35), His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26), His miracles (John 2:11), His vicarious and atoning death (1 Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9), His resurrection (John 11:25, 1 Corinthians 15:4), His ascension to the right hand of God (Mark 16:19), His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11).

**We believe** in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature and that we are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16–19, 5:24; Romans 3:23, 5:8–9; Ephesians 2:8–10; Titus 3:5).

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of condemnation (John 5:28–29).

**We believe** in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9, 1 Corinthians 12:12–13, Galatians 3:26–28). **We believe** in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by who's indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13–14; 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19–20; Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).

We believe that the term *marriage* has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture (Genesis 2:18-25). We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other (1 Corinthians 6:18, 7:2-5; Hebrews 13:4). We believe that God's command is that there be no sexual intimacy outside or apart from marriage between a man and a woman.

**We believe** that God wonderfully foreordained and immutably created each person as either male or female in conformity with their biological sex. These two distinct yet complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Genesis 1:26-27)
